



Lawrie Savage

Lawrie joined the federal government's Department of Insurance (now OSFI) in Ottawa in 1966 and from 1977 until 1985 he headed up the DOI division responsible for regulation of general insurance companies in Canada. He has been a senior executive in the Canadian insurance industry and from 1990 until 1995 served as Superintendent of Insurance for the province of Ontario. In 1997 Lawrie founded Lawrie Savage & Associates Inc, a consulting firm specializing in financial regulation. Since that time Lawrie has worked on or overseen more than 100 projects in more than 45 countries, in the fields of insurance, pensions, credit unions and banking.

Lawrie is a director of ICICI Bank of Canada where he serves on the Risk Committee and the Audit Committee. He is also Chair of the Property and Casualty Insurance Compensation Corporation. He is a Program Leader and member of the Insurance Advisory Board of the Toronto Centre. Lawrie is also an Executive Fellow at the School of Public Policy at the University of Calgary, where he is involved with the Financial Markets Regulatory Program.

Lawrie holds a BSc in mathematics from the University of Calgary and an MBA (Dean's List) from the Ivey Business School in London, Ontario.
