

Biography for Andrei Sulzenko

Andrei Sulzenko is an Executive Fellow at The School of Public Policy, University of Calgary. He has more than forty years experience in public policy - first in the federal government and since 2005 as a consultant specializing in economic development, innovation, and trade and investment issues. His consulting practice has involved numerous policy-related assignments, principally for federal government departments and agencies. He has also worked for various private sector and non-profit organizations and for government-sponsored expert panels and advisory bodies.

Mr. Sulzenko worked for the federal government from 1972 to 2004, culminating in the position of Senior Assistant Deputy Minister, Policy at Industry Canada from 1996-2004, where he was responsible for micro-economic policy and analysis, marketplace legislation and foreign investment review. In 2003 he was awarded the Head of the Public Service Award for Excellence in Policy.

He is a graduate of McGill and Queen's Universities and has served as Fellow and Adjunct Professor at the latter's School of Policy Studies.
