



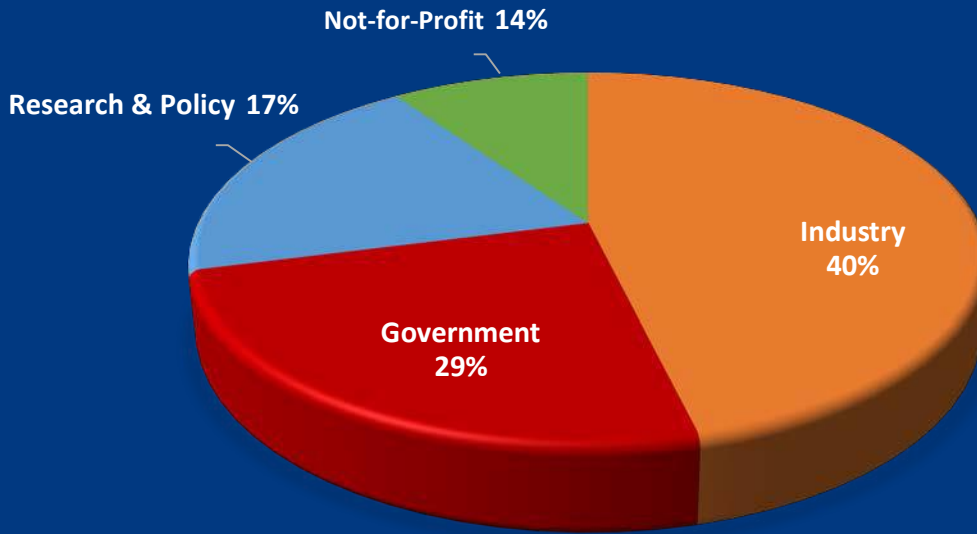
THE SCHOOL OF PUBLIC POLICY
