

Lindsay Tedds is the Scientific Director of the Fiscal and Economic Policy program at The School of Public Policy and an Associate Professor in the Department of Economics at the University of Calgary. Lindsay is a specialist in applied economic research and policy analysis, with a particular focus on the design and implementation of tax policy. Her work spans a number of topics including the underground economy, income underreporting, the tax treatments of stock options and exploration expenses, user levies, insider disclosure, generosity of coverage for assisted reproduction, and birth seasonality.
