Bev Dahlby was Professor of Economics at the University of Alberta from 1978 to 2012 and Distinguished Fellow Tax and Economic Growth and Research Director of the School of Public Policy at the University of Calgary from 2012 to 2020. He has [published extensively](#) on tax policy and fiscal federalism. In 2010, he was awarded the Doug Purvis Memorial Prize by the Canadian Economics Association for a publication with the C.D. Howe Institute on Canadian fiscal policy.

Bev has extensive experience as a policy advisor to the federal and provincial governments. He was a member of the Technical Committee on Business Taxation in 1996-97 and served as Director of Research for the Alberta Financial Investment and Planning Advisory Commission in 2007. Bev was a member of the Expert Panel on Federal Support to Research and Development in 2010-11. In 2016, he was Chair of the British Columbia Commission on Tax Competitiveness. From 2013 to 2019, Bev was a member of Canada's Ecofiscal Commission and in 2019 a member of the Blue Ribbon Panel which reported on the Government of Alberta's finances. He has also served as a consultant on fiscal reforms with the World Bank in Mexico and Brazil, with the IMF in Malawi, the Thailand Development Research Institute.

Bev is currently a Senior Fellow of the Fraser Institute, Fellow in Residence with the C.D. Howe Institute, and a CESifo Research Network Fellow.
